I have direct experience of Forest School (Level 3) and Forest ecology (BSc, DIC, PhD). and business, (MBA and worked at SME and international levels). I am not a trainer so can give a different perspective on FSA issues. I have contributed to marketing, fundraising, policy development and strategic thinking and have been the Deputy Chair for 3 years. I established the FSA Teemill site for T-shirt sales. I have experience of working in committees (FSA and school governor) and have worked with volunteers (in the Portsmouth Repair Café, I was invited to establish and sit on the Portsmouth Diocese Environmental Advisory Group, I am providing ecology expertise to a protest group in Wales trying to prevent the destruction of an ancient woodland). I have experience of writing business plans (e.g. the copyright for a plan to develop a nematode production business was sold for £25,000). I am happy to make time and effort available to the FSA.
